# betterArts: 2022 Residency Program



betterArts is a not-for-profit 501(c)3 corporation providing an opportunity for creative exploration and growth to visual artists, musicians, potters, sculptors, authors, poets, journalists, dancers, musicians, and creators of every ilk within the context of Better Farm's dynamic environment.

Located 10 miles from Alexandria Bay and the Thousand Islands, Better Farm is situated on 65 acres of property offering an unparalleled rural living experience. Artists-in-residence have 24/7 access to the Art Barn, a 2,500-square-foot studio and gallery space featuring recording studio, radio station, easels, electric kiln, kick wheel, anvil, and myriad art supplies. The property additionally features open-air shop space for woodworkers and welders; on-site sauna, pond, gardens, animal sanctuary, and forests great for hiking and snowshoeing. Residents may choose between a private bedroom in the main house or seasonal rustic cabin (varying price points apply). Food is stocked in a shared kitchenette for residents to prepare on their own; sit-down, family-style meals are also regular occurrences. All provided food is vegan.

betterArts residents are expected to interact and participate in the goings-on around the property (helping with farming, doing minor construction projects, community outreach, hosting a workshop, or assisting with other odd jobs) an average of 3-5 hours per week in addition to their own work on their art. Artists may set their own schedules and choose which projects they participate in.

All those accepted for residency are expected to work seriously—and to conduct themselves in a manner that aids fellow residents in their endeavors. Standards for admission are talent, a coherent project proposal to be completed while here, a desire to live and work at Better Farm. and a willingness to have a go at the Better Theory: a belief that each moment presents us with the opportunity for exponential personal growth.
